Step 2: Coordinate with Earle Fincher (earlefincher@gmail.com) to set a date when you can serve at the Hickory Soup Kitchen to prepare and serve the food to the homeless on a Sunday late morning/ early afternoon. Approximately 10:30am—1:00 pm.

Step 3: Arrange transportation for all your members to arrive in time to do all that is necessary.

Step 4: Serve the homeless community by building relationships and loving on them and making them feel special and valuable.

Step 5: Tell us how it went! Please give us feedback so that we can continue to improve on the *Serving*TOGETHER experience.
